## Memorandum for Academic Exchanges and Cooperation between Japan Museum Management Academy, Japan and

Korean Society of Museum Studies, Korea

Japan Museum Management Academy (JMMA), Japan, and Korean Society of Museum Studies (KSOMS), The Republic of Korea, hereinafter referred to as "the two parties", fully recognizing that academic exchanges and cooperation between the two parties would be beneficial to all concerned, hereby affirm their intention to encourage such exchanges and cooperation.

As a general declaration of intent, the two parties agree to act as follows:

- 1. The two parties shall encourage the following activities in Museum Studies, including Cultural Heritage Studies, Museum Management and Marketing Studies, and related fields:
- (1) Exchange of members and researchers;
- (2) Collaborative research and joint academic meetings;
- (3) Exchange of information, publications and materials for academic purposes; and
- (4) Other academic activities as may be mutually agreed by the two parties to this Memorandum.
- 2. The above mentioned activities shall be realized by means of consultation and the exchange of relevant information between appropriate members of two parties.
- 3. This Memorandum shall become effective immediately upon being signed by the official representatives of the two parties and shall remain valid for a period of five (5) years. This Memorandum may be renewed for a further period of five (5) years by mutual Memorandum prior to the date of expiry.
- 4. This Memorandum may be amended by mutual Memorandum.

5. This Memorandum is made in English in two copies, one for each party.
